On Saturday, they will then take part in an intercultural workshop with the same choir and their conductor Vinzenz Weissenburger, perform in the prestigious St Mary's Church in the evening and will also explore Germany's biggest artistic and musical metropolis. In preparation for this, the choir had a joint concert with the Huron High school A Capella Choir and Bel Canto Choir on the 22nd of March in Malahide, which was a big success for everybody involved. With the help of this concert, a Table Quiz and a Clothes Donation project, the choir fundraised a substantial sum of money which is all going towards their recording activities and the tour to Berlin.
